



The Forum is a high-level platform designed to accelerate investment, technology transfer, and partnerships in Ghana’s agribusiness sector. It brings together Ghanaian enterprises, European companies, investors, and public institutions in a structured, results-oriented setting.

Its objective is to facilitate concrete partnerships and investments by connecting Ghanaian agribusinesses—particularly SMEs and processors—with European technology providers, industrial partners, and financiers.

Ghana’s agribusiness sector is undergoing a transformation focused on value addition, agro-processing, and export competitiveness. European expertise aligns strongly with these priorities. However, investment remains below potential due to limited structured engagement platforms. The Forum is designed to address this gap.
